

Statement regarding the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) - Section 6(h)

Dear Sir or Madam,

Under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) evaluates potential risks from new and existing chemicals in order to prevent or reduce harmful environmental impacts. On June 22nd, 2016, the Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act was enacted as an amendment to TSCA. EPA identified five PBT chemicals for accelerated action in 2016 that meet TSCA Section 6(h) criteria and published a proposed rule in 2019. EPA published the final rules on January 6th, 2021. Under them, the following five substances may no longer be sold as substances or as substances in articles:

2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)	CAS number: 732-26-3
Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd)	CAS number: 87-68-3
Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)	CAS number: 133-49-3
decaBDE decabromodiphenylether	CAS number: 1163-19-5
Phenol isopropylated Phosphate (PIP)	CAS number: 68937-41-7

To ensure that our products always comply with the current regulatory requirements, we review them regularly and are in close contact with our suppliers.

We hereby certify that our products do NOT contain any of the substances listed above in accordance with Section 6(h) of TSCA.
